Hotel Courtesy and Regulations

Be courteous to other guests that are staying at the hotel. We are not the only group staying at the hotel. Loud talking, doors slamming, etc. are distractions to other guests and will not be tolerated at any time. Please remember that any damage to the hotel is the sole responsibility of the student(s) involved.

At The Hotel:

It is your responsibility to be up in time for breakfast and loading of luggage and other items. Everyone must report to breakfast provided at the hotel.

Rooms assigned to girls are off limits to boys and rooms assigned to boys are off limits to girls.

Students are responsible for the orderliness of their assigned room, and any damage to this area or any area within the hotel by a student will result in the student being financially responsible for the damage. DO NOT take articles from the room. If anything is missing after checkout, the entire room will be held responsible.

Other Rules

1. Everyone must be accompanied by at least one or more friend(s) when not on the bus. This may include a chaperone.

Additional info:
